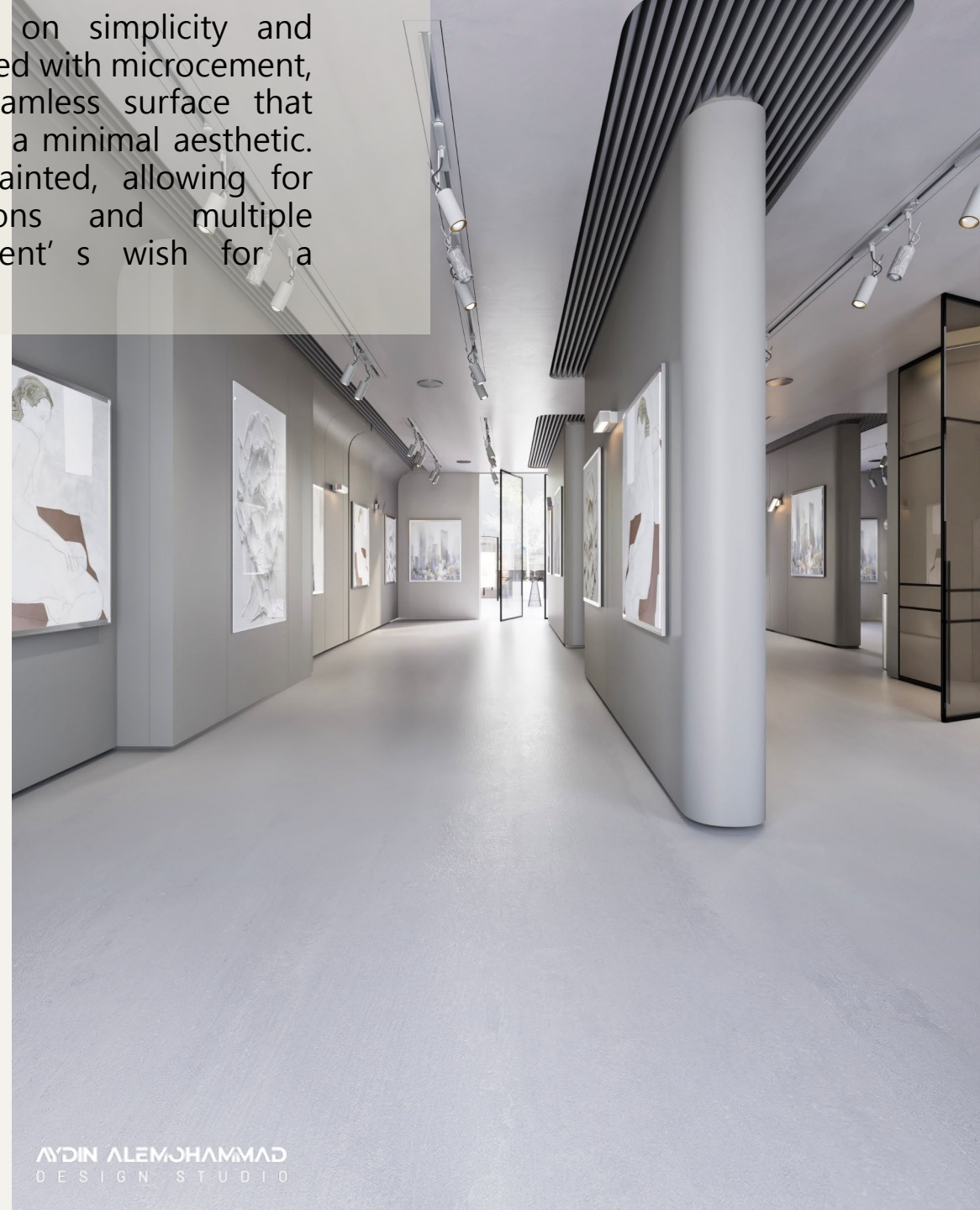

The project is an art gallery located in Tehran, designed to serve as a neutral backdrop for the display of diverse artworks. The client's main request was to create a colorless and calm environment that would allow the art pieces to take visual priority.



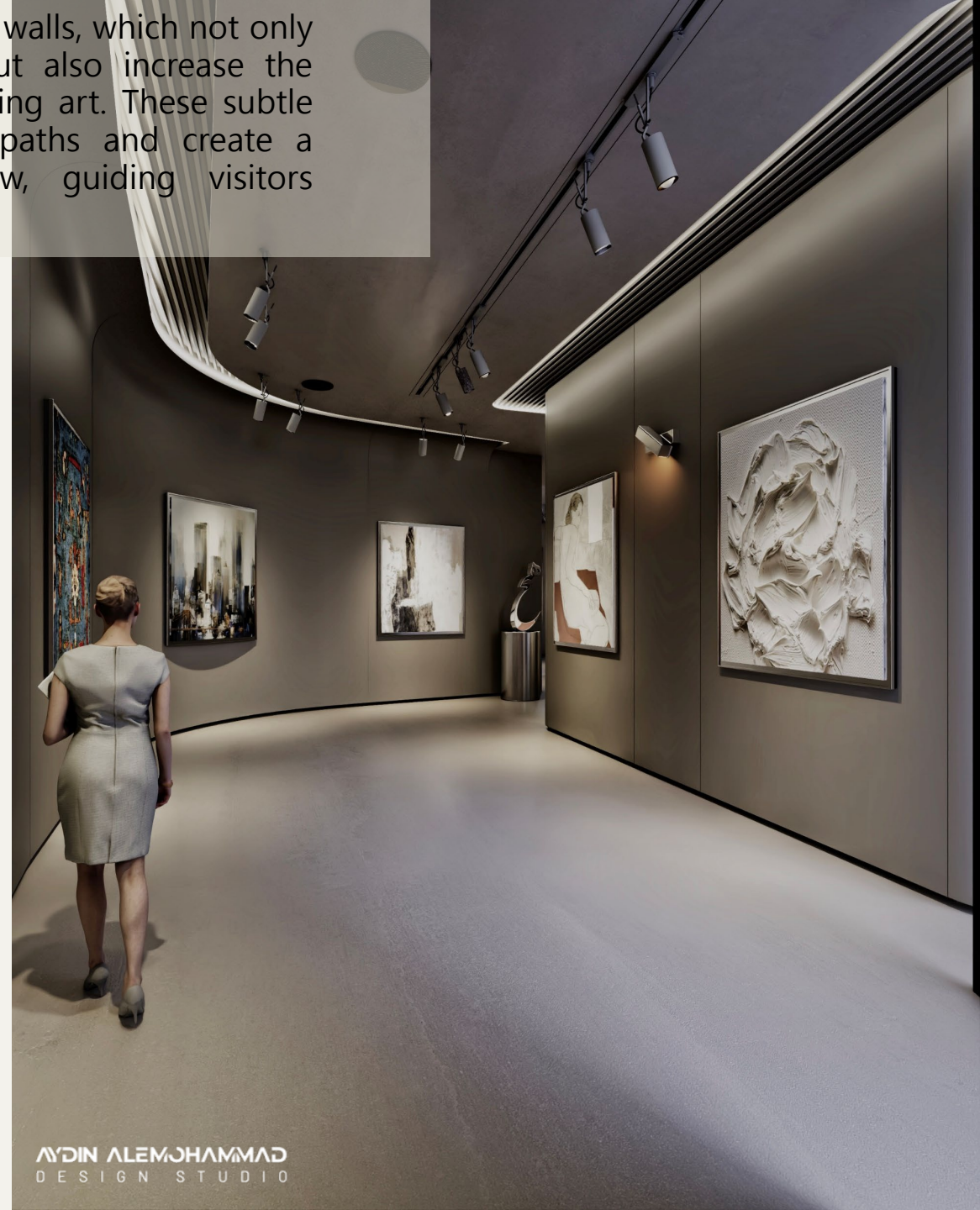
The overall concept is based on simplicity and neutrality. The entire floor is finished with microcement, providing a continuous and seamless surface that reflects light softly and maintains a minimal aesthetic. The walls are plastered and painted, allowing for flexibility in future exhibitions and multiple configurations as per the client's wish for a multifunctional space.







The gallery space features curved walls, which not only soften the spatial experience but also increase the available surface area for displaying art. These subtle curves help define movement paths and create a dynamic yet calm spatial flow, guiding visitors intuitively through the exhibition.





On both sides of the gallery, there are two terraces functioning as extensions of the interior. Each terrace includes greenery, lounge areas, and a café bar, providing a place for visitors to rest and socialize while maintaining a visual connection to the exhibition space.







Natural light is filtered carefully to enhance the perception of materials and artworks, while artificial lighting is designed to be flexible and adjustable for different types of exhibitions. The overall result is a serene, balanced, and timeless space that supports the gallery's curatorial vision without distraction.
