Earth-toned palettes and rounded furnishings soften the overall aesthetic, while high-contrast materials such as black marble and cognac leather add a refined executive edge. The combination of modern materials—such as terrazzo planters, velvet upholstery, and brushed brass details—adds a sophisticated edge to the organic palette, making the Marina Office a refined and inviting workspace.
