








Crystal chandeliers and textured marble complement warm wood tones and plush fabrics, establishing a balance between modern elegance and comfort.





















Tital Al Ghaf Residential






















Dubai Villa



Abstract artworks and curated décor add depth and personality. Every corner of this villa exudes serene sophistication and contemporary charm.



























































This project is a testament to quiet luxury and thoughtful spatial composition.










The design of this mountain villa in *Polour* embraces the raw beauty of its natural surroundings through the extensive use of earthy materials such as stone, concrete, and textured finishes. The architecture blends modern minimalism with a rugged, grounded aesthetic, reflecting the mountainous terrain outside.



Large glass openings allow panoramic views and natural light to flood the interior spaces, while the material palette—rough stone, warm wood, and muted tones—creates a calm, contemplative environment. The spaces are functionally divided yet visually connected, with features like a sculptural stone island, exposed structural textures, and a seamless indoor pool area that echo the untouched essence of the site.


















This villa offers a refined yet organic retreat, rooted deeply in the spirit of the landscape.









The design merges brutalist elements with contemporary elegance, offering a refined retreat that remains connected to its rugged surroundings.


